CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Acting 124

Learn live theatre through theatre games, developing a character and ultimately performing at the end of the week.

Aliens, UFO's & Monsters 312

Students will use their imagination to draw, paint and sculpt original aliens, UFO's and monsters.

Animals, Animals, Animals 310

Have fun learning basic techniques while you draw, paint and sculpt your favorite animals and creatures! Draw cartoon and realistic animals with pencil, oil pastels, colored pencils and markers. Use acrylics, ink, wood, and sculpey clay as you paint and sculpt animals of your choice.

Anime and Manga 121

Discover the fun world of drawing Japanese characters from Japan's hottest artists. This is a fun class to draw cartoon figures in a unique way.

Art Explosion! 100

Young artists explore their creativity with an explosion of fun art materials and projects! Students will paint, sculpt, draw, glue and more during this exciting class. Please have your child wear an old shirt or paint smock to class.

Art of Harry Potter Day Camp 345

If you are a fan of the Harry Potter books or movies you will love this class. Come expecting to be sorted into houses and work hard to win the house cup! Create your own wands and wand boxes, brew up some interesting potions, make spell books, attend Care of Magical Creatures class, sculpt your favorite creature, visit Honey Duke's Sweet, plant something interesting in herbology and lots more! Class will include new projects not offered before.

Basic Drawing 151, 331

Learn the basics of drawing, which is the foundation of all art. Discover drawing in graphite, chalk, charcoal and ink.

Beads, Bracelets and Necklaces 141, 232

Students will make friendship bracelets and necklaces as well as beads from sculpey clay. They will also make jewelry from manufactured beads.

Bookmaking 300

Learn a variety of simple ways to create different styles of handmade books like scrolls, soft covers and mini books. The transform your book into a personal work of art with embellishments, drawings, illustrations and writing!

Costume Design 323

Exploration of theatrical costumes including a field trip to Sleepy Hollow's Costume shop to create your own costume

Creative Boxes & Jewelry 211, 340

Students paint, stamp and decorate boxes to be used for their jewelry or for other special things. They will learn how to make jewelry and create fun bracelets, necklaces and even key chains.

Creative Painting Studio 221

Students will experiment with different types of paint. Basic painting techniques will be taught and students can be expressive with their paint.

Creative Sculpture Studio 131

Students will experiment with many forms of sculpture and different media. Learn the basics and explore your creativity!

Discover the World of Ancient Egypt 322

Students will explore a variety of art forms in the class, from drawing on papyrus to sculpting hieroglyphs and scarabs. Mummies and pyramids will also be explored.

Doodle, Draw Design! 120

Explore basic drawing skills with pencil, marker, oil pastels, colored pencil and charcoal. Doodle from your imagination; Draw what you see and Design something new!

Drawing Cartoons 302

Learn basic cartoon techniques to bring humor to your characters. Students will learn how to be creative in developing their original cartoons.

Drawing Cartoons, Comics, Anime and Manga 255

Have fun and learn simple ways to create your own cartoon characters whether it is in a traditional cartooning style or the popular anime and Manga styles. Learn how to create expressions, features and personalities for your characters. Use your characters in short comic strips or Manga. Explore new techniques, a variety of art mediums and have fun talking to other obsessed fans.

Drawing Dinosaurs and Making Fossils
212

For the student who loves science and art. Learn how to draw dinosaurs the simple way and make fossils that look real.

Dragons & Imaginary Creatures
111

Students can enjoy the world of fantasy dragons and unusual creatures by creating them with colored pencil and markers. Students will learn how to develop their drawing skills to create beautiful dragons that seem to come alive!

Drawing and Sculpting Animals
242

Students will learn basic drawing techniques and how to draw animals the easy way.

The class will look at textures and values to help their animals look 3-D. The class will sculpt an animal using clay.

Drawing Super Heroes
201

Have fun drawing your favorite Super Heroes—Spiderman, Super Man, etc. while developing drawing skills. Make several drawings of various Super Heroes and how to use color to make drawings real.

Duct Tape Art
240

Duct tape can be used for everything and anything... why not make some art with it? Learn how to make fun and functional works of art from this common material. Choose from a variety of multi-colored duct tape to create duct-tape "paintings" and collages, cover objects in duct-tape and other embellishments to transform them, learn how to make your own duct-tape wallet, book, purse or tie and use your imagination to craft strange duct-tape sculptures.

Fairies, Goblins & Dragons
202

Take a trip through an enchanted forest and discover goblins on rocks, and fairies and dragons flying. The class will draw, paint and sculpt various art projects of Fairies, Goblins and Dragons.

Fancy Fairy Club
101, 301

Fun class for little girls and boys to decorate a costume and fairy objects to dress up in and enjoy themselves. Each child will learn to paint, use stamps to create unique designs on their costumes. They will have fun with their imaginations in this class! When you register, please include the size of your child.

Fun Creations For Your Room
210

Use your creativity to craft fun things to bring life to your room! Create your own bulletin boards, funky lights, unique storage containers, picture frames, wall decorations and more! Class will include some new projects not offered last year.

Glass Etching
250, 330

Create wonderful glass designs by etching glass. Students will make a small hanging window ornament and etch a mirror tile. Students also bring in glasses or other objects to etch, which can serve a functional purpose and still be fun.

Hannah Montana Madness
104

Come and dance to hit songs by Hannah Montana. We'll learn dance moves and choreography and perform a dance for friends and family at the end of the week. We'll also have fun with daily crafts and make things to wear for the mini-performance. No previous dance experience required.

Is the Pirates Life for You?
145

Wanted: Girls and boys of the high sea to join in for a week of creative mischief making with Capt. Red Anne Flint and First Mate Blind Beard. Once given new pirate names and crew positions (think Jack Sparrow!), make maps, messages in a bottle, create ship sculptures, transform treasure chests, make pirate jewelry, sculpt and draw pirate related art and more! * Older students taking class will have the option to take projects in their own directions.

Japanese Creations
150, 321

Students have fun painting their own umbrella, chopsticks and fan to add to their wonderful Japanese items. They will have the unique opportunity to wear a Kimono and experience a Japanese Tea Ceremony.

Japanese Kimono
140, 311

What exciting fun to dye, paint and print designs on a Kimono made just for you! Also enjoy learning to write with Kanji letters on the Japanese Obi to wrap around the beautiful Kimono! Students will have the unique opportunity to experience a Japanese Tea Ceremony. The only requirement is when you register, please include their size.

Japanese Silk Painting
220

Learn about the Japanese culture and the beautiful art of painting on silk fabric using colorful dyes and resists to create exquisite works of art. Students will also have the fun opportunity to wear a Japanese Kimono while taking the class. The teacher of this class went to Japan as a Fulbright Scholarship Recipient, where she was taught the Art of Silk Painting from a Master Painter who painted the robes for the Emperor's wife.

Midsummer Ballet Fairies
203, 303

This is a very special dance class with a fantastic performing opportunity at the end. We will learn a fairy dance to perform at the annual "Midsummer Celebration of Light" on June 19th. You will get to wear a gossamer fairy costume, make a crown, and use a light-up wand. No previous dance experience required. There will be a required short run-through at the stage at Sleepy Hollow Arts Park either Friday night June 18th or Saturday morning June 19th before the performance that evening. Participants will keep their crown and wand.

Musical Theatre I
132

Job Christenson teaches an intense introduction to musical theatre. There will be discussions on musical theatre history, training, song choices and acting, dancing and music technique that directly apply to the future in musical theatre. This class will also focus on how to become a strong confident leader in your theatre and music programs at your schools and community theatre. Two or more songs must be prepared with memorization ready for performance in class. Don't be intimidated by this. This is crucial to your training and can be any song that you choose.

Musical Theatre II
233

It is highly recommended that you take all the Musical Theatre sessions that are being offered in consecutive order for the best results. However, all students are encouraged to enroll when it is not available. This also means that there will only be a very short revue of past information. After that the class will move quickly ahead exploring a pre-professional approach to the discipline of musical theatre. Two more different songs will be expected to be prepared for this class. You will also do monologues and scenes from musicals.

Musical Theatre III
332

This class will focus on a final project of three production numbers from three different musicals. Each student will learn how to function and perform a final piece where they will have to accomplish quick memorization, choreography, solo lines and ensemble music. This group will give a special performance at the MIDSUMMER CELEBRATION on June 19th.

Musical Theater Vocal Techniques
105

Bring a song to life! Constructive coaching will help with the interpretation and delivery of a show tune of your choice.

Nature Art
200

The natural world around us has so much to teach. Use and collect things from nature to create art with during the week. Learn ways to paint and draw the trees outside, landscapes, flowers and birds. Materials are provided but feel free to bring any rocks, twigs, feathers, shells or other natural items to use as well.

No Bones about it!
Skeleton Art
230

Actually, lots of bones about it.... this class will take students from drawing stick figures to skeletons in no time. Learn how to draw your skeletons in different positions doing normal or sill things...how about a rock star skeleton with a Mohawk and guitar? It's all up to you. Draw, paint and sculpt a variety of skeleton themed art projects. Learn a little bit about our bones, study the skeleton in art and rattle your bones with this fun class.

Open Art Studio
351

Students will be able to choose the materials they want to use. They can paint, draw or sculpt in this open studio class. Basic techniques will be taught according to the materials.

Painting Studio
110

Have fun learning basic and more adventurous techniques with acrylic, watercolors and ink. Spray, brush, drip or swat color on with a variety of brushes and tools. Experience realistic and abstract painting. Self-expression is encouraged!

Painting Super Heroes
350

Students learn how to draw their Super Heroes and then how to paint those images. This class raises self-confidence in their art skills by teaching them new techniques of painting.

Party in the USA
133

Come dance to new and fun hit songs by Miley Cyrus. This is a dance class and craft camp rolled into one. This camp includes learning dance moves, daily crafts and a special mini-performance for friends and family at the end of the week. No previous dance experience required.

Scribble, Scratch & Stippling
112

Let's scribble and scratch outside the borders. Students will use drawing materials, paper, cardboard, and other non-traditional art materials in this class.

Sculpture Fun
320

Experiment and create with clay, wood, wire, odd and ends and more. Sculpt animals, people, vehicles, buildings or wherever your imagination leads you. Design, Build, Explore!

Splash into Watercolor
231

Students discover the beautiful qualities of painting with watercolors for a fresh look to their artwork. Students will be taught the basics of painting a watercolor and how to develop their painting skills to a higher level.

Splash, Splatter & Spill
102

Let's splash and splatter outside the borders. Students will experiment with different types of paint and other materials. This is a great class for self-expression.

Storybook Theatre
223

Act out some of your favorite fairy tales on stage. A full performance will be at the end of the week for parents and friends.

Strings, Advanced
123

For students entering the 9th-12th grade. Increased exposure to orchestral techniques and terminology used in upper level orchestra. Indicate Instrument _____

For students who are beginning their string experience; they will learn the basics of playing a string instrument. Indicate instrument _____

Strings, Intermediate
113

For students who have played at least one year. Expand string knowledge and technique with a variety of orchestral literature. Indicate instrument _____

Tie-Dye & Art of Shibori
130, 241

Learn the basics of how to tie-dye fabric and also the wonderful art of Japanese Tie Dye Shibori. Students learn exquisite ways of dying fabric for a beautiful wall hanging. Students need to bring a 100% cotton t-shirt for the first day of class. * Teacher of this class went to Japan as a Fulbright recipient, where she was taught the Art of Shibori from the Master Painter who painted the robes of the Emperor's wife.

Watercolor Magic
341

Learn basic techniques of watercolor and study different styles of this spontaneous medium. A great class for self-expression.
